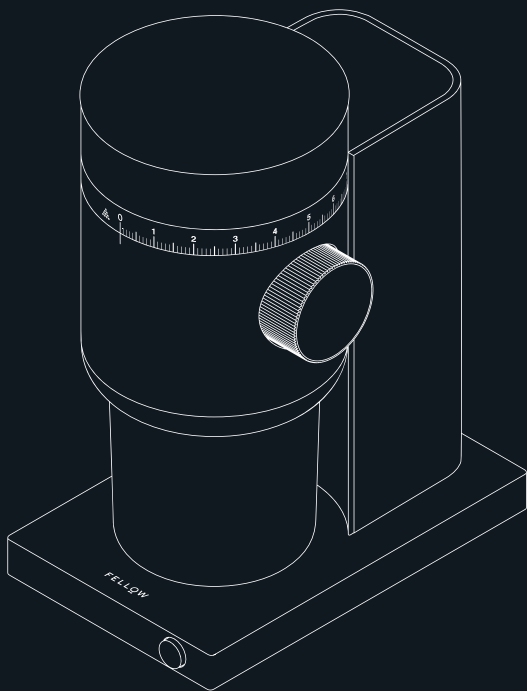

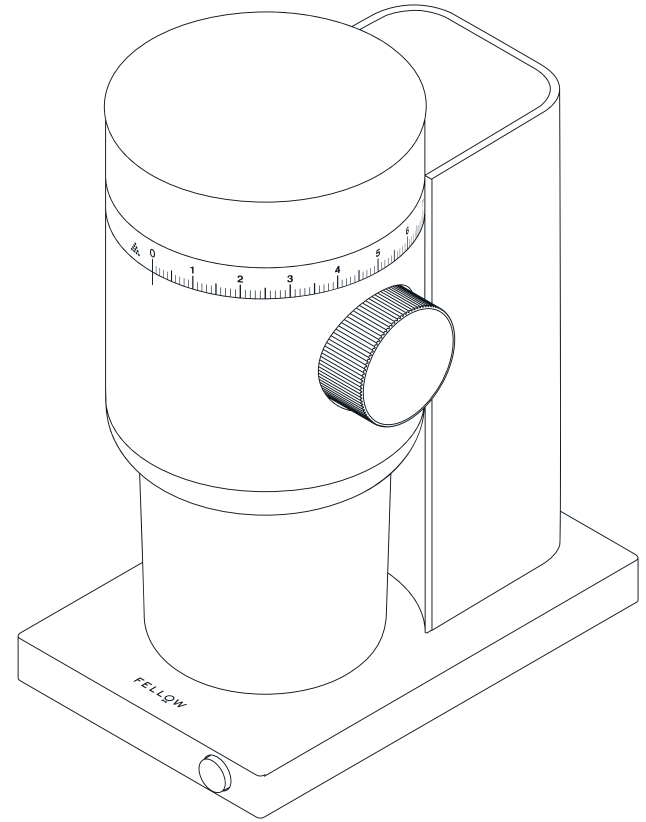

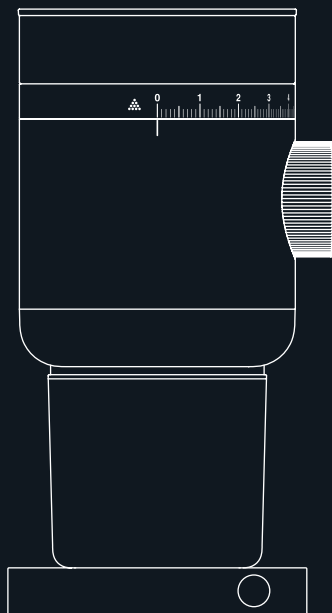

Autostops when grinding is done. No hovering over your grinder.

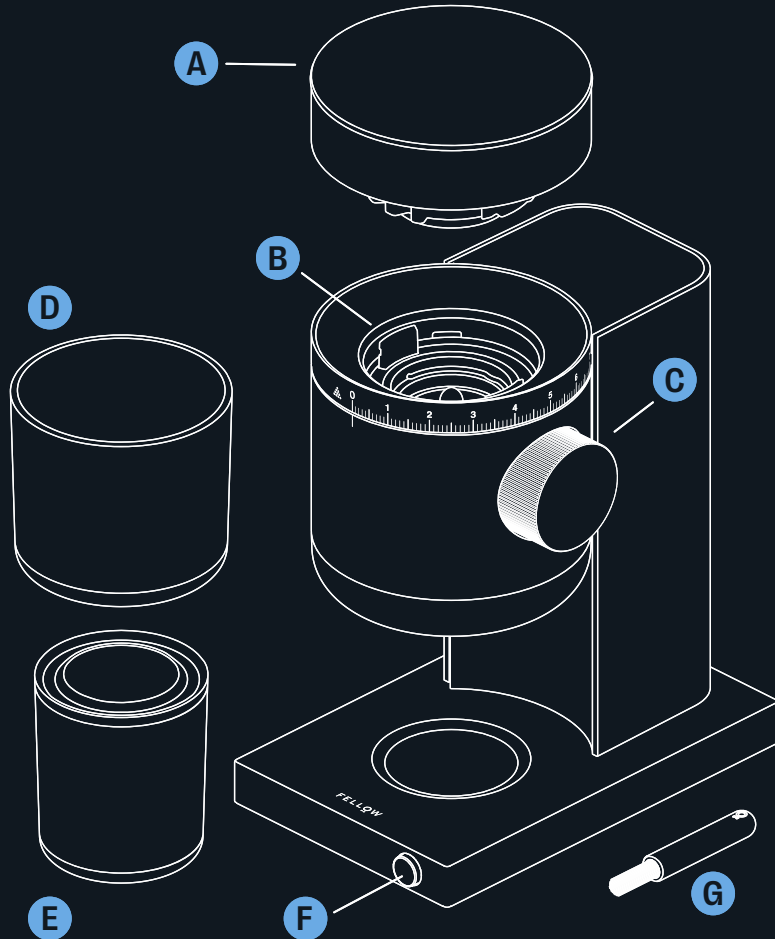

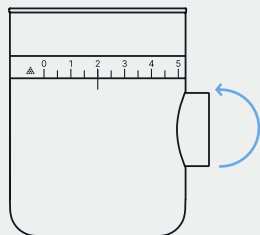

| A SINGLE DOSE LOAD BIN | Sized to maximize bean freshness with an under-lid grind guide. Flip the lid over to find 20 and 40 gram measuring compartments or fill the lid to the top for 100 grams (plastic lid only). |
| B 48 MM STAINLESS STEEL CONICAL BURRS | Designed for fast, precise and consistent grinding with outstanding flavor. |
| C GRIND ADJUSTMENT KNOB | Rotate to select grind size from fine (0) to coarse (10), with micro-steps in between. |
| D COFFEE CATCH CUP | Magnetically snaps beneath the chute to catch your grinds. 100 g capacity for all brewed coffee methods. |
| E ESPRESSO CATCH CUP | 30 g capacity for grinding espresso into, then pouring into your portafilter. Compatible with 54 mm and 58 mm portafilters. |
| F POWER BUTTON WITH AUTO STOP | Press once to begin grinding and it will automatically stop once all the beans are ground. Long press to grind for 45 seconds. |
| G BRUSH | For brushing out grounds and general cleaning. Magnetically attaches to the top of the rear tower. |

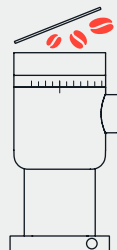
Start Here

Adjust the knob to select your grind size—higher numbers mean coarser.

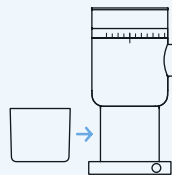

Use a scale or the load bin lid to measure your dose of coffee beans, pour into Opus' load bin, and re-install the lid.

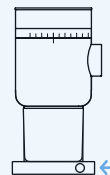
For Brewed Coffee

Place the larger coffee catch cup underneath the chute.

④



Press the power button once to grind. Opus will auto stop when all the beans are ground.

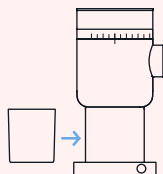

Pour grounds into your favorite brewer and start the brewing process!

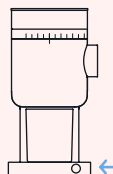
For Espresso

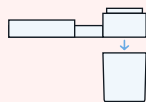
Place the smaller espresso catch cup underneath the chute.

④



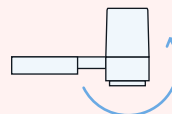
Press the power button once to grind. Opus will auto stop when all the beans are ground.

⑤



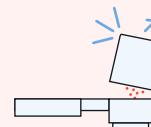
Remove the espresso catch cup and place your portafilter firmly on top of it.

⑥



Flip over so the portafilter is upright.

⑦



Tap the catch cup to loosen any grounds and then remove it. Now you're ready to tamp and pull a shot.

RATIO RECOMMENDATIONS

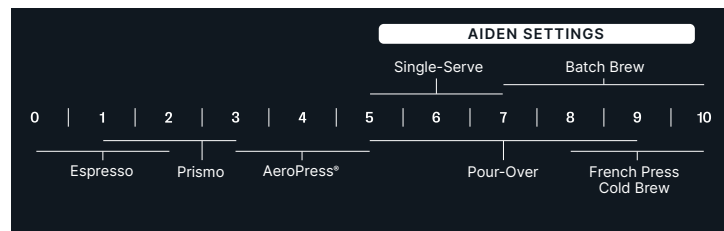
Coffee dosage guide

18 grams → Double espresso
20 grams → Fellow Prismo
AeroPress® Attachment
25 grams → AeroPress®
20 grams → Pour-over for one
40 grams → Pour-overs for two
60 grams → French press for 3
80 grams → Traditional cold brew
82.5 grams → 10-cup Aiden instant brew

Coffee-to-water

1:2 → Espresso
1:2.5 → Fellow Prismo
AeroPress® Attachment
1:8 → Traditional cold brew
1:14 → French press
1:15 → AeroPress®
1:16 → Pour-over

GRIND SETTINGS



For darker roasts, select a higher number within the recommended grind range.

TIPS + TRICKS

CLEAN AND CALIBRATE WITH CARE

Treat your Opus right at fellowproducts.com/pages/gear-guides

- ① Don't store beans in Opus. Pour beans into the load bin right before grinding. The fresher the coffee, the better the flavor.
- ② Dial in your espresso using the grind adjustment knob to make granular changes to grind size.
- ③ If your brew tastes sour, try grinding slightly finer. If your brew tastes bitter, try grinding slightly coarser.
- ④ Short press the power button to start grinding and Opus will stop grinding automatically when it detects the hopper is empty. Long press the power button and Opus will grind for 45 seconds.
